JLPT Japanese-Language Proficiency Test

Dear examinees

Thank you for registering to the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) that will take place on Sunday Dec. 5th, 2019. The examination will take place at the **Hebrew University of Jerusalem – Givat Ram.**

This examination is organized by the [Israeli Association for Japanese Studies](#), [The Japanese embassy in Israel](#) and is hosted by the Department of [Asian studies at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem](#).

The examination will begin at 11:00 A.M and will finish around 14:30 PM depending on the level of your test. The examinees are to arrive at least half an hour before the test (10:30) in order to find their appointed exam room and for the examiners to verify your documentations.

Please bring with you

1. Test Voucher with picture
2. Black pencil (HB or 2)
3. Eraser and pencil sharpener
4. ID card
5. **Green pass \ Recovery certificate \ Negative Covid test**

Similarly, it is advised to bring a watch which does not make a sound and does not have any translation functions, to the exam for your convenience.

It is forbidden to leave the room during the exam (including for the washroom).

It is forbidden to drink, eat or use cellular devices during the exam.

Please, turn off your cellphones for the entire duration of the exam, put them in your bags and leave your bags in the corner of your classroom.

You will have breaks between parts of the examinations where you can drink/eat/go to the bathroom.

- The cafeteria, Coffee stands, and other Student facilities will be available.

Directions:

- **From Jerusalem – central station:** egged bus line no.68\66\66'א\14\15
- **From the Yitzhak Navon train station – Same routs.**

Mapping signs will be put near the entrance.

For those who wish to come by car – We are unable to give vehicle entry permits to campus parking lot. You are free to park at the blue&white parking spaces around campus.
